Events this year have placed into the starkest possible relief the overarching importance of America's energy choices. In the spring we had the disastrous electricity price shocks in California. Last month, the unrest in the mideast savagely exploded in our midst, and along with the unprecedented human and economic toll, reminded us of our continued dependence on mideast

oil and all of its international political implications. All the while, we hear calls for drilling in our most precious and delicate Alaska National Wildlife Refuge for a few month's worth of oil.

Ever since the 1970s when our two prominent speakers, David Freeman and Amory Lovins published their seminal works (respectively, *A Time to Choose* and *Soft Energy Paths*), we have known that this country could create an energy future that supports a sound economy and a livable environment.

In the meantime, technological advances have enhanced the cost-effectiveness of alternatives to a pure supply-side orientation that depletes our resources, threatens our health, makes our economy fragile and risks our national security.

Still, our national will has flagged. We are far behind where we need to be, and the consequences of inaction are more frightening than ever. ***This conference will focus, not on theory, but on getting the job done.*** Each sector, public and private, will be asked to report on what they are committing to do ***in the next year*** to move our region towards real energy security.
